Existing adult flies will not be affected. Start feeding before flies appear and continue use until cold weather marks the end of fly season. Use this product as part of a fly control program aimed at reducing fly populations. House and stable flies can breed and develop in decaying vegetable matter or spilled silage on premises in the cattle's, horse's, swine's, sheep's and goat's environment. Good sanitation practices, such as cleaning up spilled feed and preventing manure build-up around barns and fences or under feed bunks, will eliminate additional breeding sites for these flies.
