Medicated:

For young nursing show lambs. For the prevention of coccidiosis in young sheep caused by *Eimeria ovinoidalis*, *E. parva*, *E. bakuensis*, and *E. crandallis*.

Caution: Use as directed.

Warning: Do not feed to sheep producing milk for food.

Directions:

Feed at a rate of 0.3 lbs to lambs weighing 20 lbs to provide 22.7 mg decoquinate per 100 lb of bodyweight (0.5 mg/kg) per day. Feed at least 28 days during period of exposure to coccidiosis or when it is likely to be a hazard.

IMPORTANT

Follow these management practices:

- Lambs should be adjusted gradually to this product (over a period of 5 to 7 days) to reduce the risk of overeating and other digestive disturbances.
- This ration can be self-fed to lambs if they are properly adjusted to the ration.
- 3. Do not allow starved lambs access to this feed.
- 4. Vaccinate all lambs to prevent enterotoxemia (overeating disease) with both C and D toxoid.
- Keep a constant supply of complete feed available to lambs.
 Do not allow fine material to accumulate in feeders.
- Provide adequate bunk space for each animal. Bunks should be well protected and well managed to prevent feed from becoming wet and moldy.
- 7. When fed from a self-feeder, adjust feeder to minimize quantity of feed accumulating in the trough.
- 8. Provide free choice salt at all times.
- 9. Fresh, clean water should be available at all times.

In groups of lambs there are certain animals who experience chronic bloat, or other digestive disturbances, and consequently, are poor performers. In addition, excess feed consumption, severe weather changes resulting in erratic feed consumption, and poorly managed feeding practices can increase the incidence of bloat in all lambs. If bloating does occur, the above management practices should be reviewed.

Caution: Store in a dry area away from insects. Do not feed moldy or insect-infested feed.

Reminder:

- Feed is perishable and should be stored in a clean, dry, wellventilated area so it will remain fresh and palatable.
- DO NOT feed moldy or insect infested feed to animals as it may cause illness, abortion or death.
- Fresh, clean water should be available at all times.
